

The Harvest Field: Our Response

“But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light” – 1 Peter 2:9

The praises of Christ: Matthew 9:35-36

1. There is good news!
 - a. Christ has overcome sin and its consequences through his death and resurrection, and he is bringing his kingdom.
2. There is a healer!
 - a. Christ has all authority and is able to heal physical and spiritual sickness.
3. There is a compassionate one!
 - a. He cares for the people that are harassed and helpless and wants them to come to him, the Good Shepherd.

1. Is the harvest plentiful or few?
2. Are the workers plentiful or are they few?
3. Who does the harvest belong to?
4. So who are we supposed to ask for more workers?
